- A meeting with the coordinators was held on 16th September 2025




- A meeting with the KG Department teachers was held on 17.09.2025 to discuss the progress of the kids and to stress the importance of micro teaching.

- The school conducted a **drawing competition** as part of the **All India Swachh Bharat Mission** initiative.




## EVENTS AND CELEBRATIONS:
